

FAQs (updated Aug 12, 2019)

Do I need to take the GRE? Yes, this is a requirement. What is the minimum score required? We are not setting a minimum score at this time. Competitive recommended scores are over 285. However, you are responsible to check your state licensing board or State department of education for any score requirements.

Will the GRE score be used in application evaluation? Yes, there may still be an influence of a GRE scores on the total evaluation measures. Given that this is a competitive process, when other factors are equal, a higher GRE score may have an influence.

What if I took the GRE already? If you took the GRE within the last 5 years, contact ETS and have them forward your official scores to NSC. We are not accepting scores older than 5 years

When should I take the GRE? We recommend that you plan early, due to date availability, to allow for time for scores sent to the institution, and to allow yourself opportunity for a repeat.

How do I take the GRE and find testing centers? Date availability changes. Go to https://www.ets.org/gre/revised_general/register/centers_dates
