ADVISING GUIDELINES

- 32 upper-division credits must be complete at NSC
- 60 credits should be completed from 4 year institutions
- Grades below a "C-" carry no credit towards major requirements.
- Education courses older than 5 years will not fulfill education major requirements.
- Program admission: Cumulative GPA 2.5 or higher
- Student Teaching/Graduation: Cumulative GPA 2.5 or higher
- Degree seeking students may take up to 21 credits per semester.
- Non-degree seeking students may take up to 15 credits per semester and are not eligible for overload.
- Marks of "I" are automatically changed to "F" if they are not made up by the last day of the next regular semester (Summer Session excluded)
