

PRAXIS SUBJECT ASSESSMENTS



The Praxis Subject Assessments (formerly the Praxis II exam) measure knowledge of specific subjects that K-12 educators will teach and general and subject-specific teaching skills and knowledge. The Praxis Subject Assessments must be taken prior to applying for student teaching. Nevada school districts will not hire any new teachers unless they have passed the specialty area Praxis Subject Assessments.
