



CALL FOR ART

Glenn & Ande Christenson School of Education Building

Nevada State's Office of Arts & Culture is pleased to announce a call for existing artwork and proposals for commissioned artwork that celebrates learners and teachers. The School of Education celebrates learning that comes from experiences in and out of the classroom.

Opening in the fall of 2021, the Glenn and Ande Christenson School of Education Building (CEB) is changing the face of education in southern Nevada by providing an innovative place to prepare more teachers to serve in Nevada's early childhood to grade 12 schools. This new building also serves as a space for collaboration and service to the community.

We welcome submissions in all mediums: painting, sculpture, printmaking, drawing, decorative arts, photography, and installation. Selected works will be housed within the School of Education and added to the Nevada State Permanent Collection, which currently features more than 120 works by Nevada artists.

Artists selected for the collection will need to create an account through www.suppliers.nevada.edu before the project can begin. We strongly encourage artists to register as a supplier when submitting their materials.

SITE INFORMATION

Artwork exhibited throughout CEB may be featured in or near the following areas:

Early Childhood Education Center (ECEC)

The Nevada State College School of Education's Early Childhood Education Center focuses on supporting the development needs of typically and atypically developing, three to five-year-old children. Possible spaces include but are not limited to: reception, education observation rooms, and various interior spaces.

- **Speech-Language Pathology Clinic**

The Speech-Language Pathology Clinic is a training site for graduate and undergraduate students in speech-language pathology. Possible spaces include but are not limited to: reception, clinic rooms specific to children and adults, and various interior spaces, including an exit adjacent to outdoor greenspace.

- **Collaboration work and learning spaces**

CEB provides remarkable spaces where formal and informal learning is encouraged, reflecting the School of Education's strong commitment to collaboration as a premier learning opportunity.

- **Nevada State Permanent Collection and Galleries**

As part of The Office of Arts & Culture's Campus as Museum program, CEB houses designated galleries with an emphasis on arts education and community-based exhibitions and installations.

- **Front Courtyard**

The front courtyard has an opportunity for a small sculpture. See the highlighted site on page immediately following the call for art.

SELECTION PROCESS

The artist or artist team will be chosen by the Office of Arts & Culture in consultation with the School of Education.

Artist(s) notification: No later than Thursday, March 31, 2022.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Proposals should contain the following information:

A. Artist Information

1. Artist name
2. Artist address
3. Artist phone
4. Artist email
5. Optional: Artist website or social media

B. Experience

Brief artist resume.

C. Letter of Intent

A brief description of your approach to public art and your interest in this project. Artist(s) should also include any relevant experience with public art, how the submitted work connects to the School of Education's commitment to learning and teaching, collaboration, and service to the community.

D. Artist Statement

A brief statement on your philosophy as an artist and why this project

E. Images of Artwork

1. Images of available work relevant to this call.
2. Include five (5) digital images of the artist's previous work and images of proposed artwork if seeking to create new work.

F. Image Summary

Summary further detailing images of existing artwork submitted for the call. Applicant(s) should utilize this template to detail title, medium, size, date completed, and cost. Label file with applicant(s) last name, e.g. "Smith_ImageSummary.

G. References

Provide three references.
